

Lavender Ameraucana

Blue chickens that lay blue eggs!



Ameraucanas are great backyard chickens. They lay blue eggs and are a soft blue color. The lavender color is fairly new in Ameraucanas and not yet an accepted color for showing, but these chicks are from a line of show quality birds and have the size and body type of show birds. Their legs will darken to a dark blue color and they will develop both beards and muffs. They are exceptionally tame and good with children.

These chicks are straight run, meaning they are not sexed and determining their sex is impossible at this age. There is a good chance of getting some males, if that is not acceptable, please look at the Cream Legbars as blue egg layers where you can be sure of getting all females. If you can have a rooster, Ameraucanas are an excellent choice, being generally well behaved and docile, but also large and alert enough to protect their hens from small predators.
