Sometimes called "Crested Cream Legbars", but the official name drops the crested part, since every Cream Legbar should have a nice crest. Created in the UK in 1939, Crested Cream Legbars have been taking the poultry hobby by storm since coming to America just a few years ago.

The big deal is that they lay beautiful blue eggs, like the best Ameraucanas, but they can also be sexed easily when hatched (a male chick has a distinct white spot on its head). The famed geneticist, RC Punnett, created this breed to be productive, autosexing layer. The blue eggs and crests were added more for whimsy, but they make this a perfect breed for people looking for something "a little different".

They are a light breed, like the leghorns they were originally created from, and they keep the high productivity and large eggs size, but don't have the nervous tendencies of many leghorns. The females in particular are quite docile and friendly, making Cream Legbars an ideal breed for first time chicken keepers.
