

# Blue Egg Sexlinks

New breed that lays blue eggs!

A new hybrid specially bred for backyard chicken keepers. Black Sexlinks have been a mainstay of the commercial hatcheries for many years, they are great layers and easily sexed as chicks because of their genetics. Our black sexlinks are special because of the parent breeds used. The male parent is a black Ameraucana, purebred, from a strain that produces very blue eggs. The female parent is a California Grey, a black barred hen that is an exceptional layer of white eggs. Together they create a hybrid with the attractive appearance and blue eggs of the Ameraucana, plus the improved laying ability of the California Grey.

Ameraucanas are great backyard chickens in every way except for one, they are extraordinarily hard to sex at a young age. Some colors can take upwards of 6 months before you can be sure your "pullet" really is female. For people that cannot have roosters, that knocks them out of the running, but now you can have the best of the Ameraucanas in a chick that is so simple to sex, you can easily check yourself. Males always have white tipping and striping on their black feathers, females are completely black.
